Warm Weather Footwear

Spring has officially arrived! As we all have been eagerly awaiting the warmer weather, you may be tempted to start wearing flip flops. Flip flops do serve a purpose. For example, they are good to use poolside so you don't burn your feet on the hot ground. They are also useful in public restrooms and locker rooms to help decrease the chance of coming in contact with plantar warts or athletes foot infections. However, don't use them for long periods of walking. They offer no arch support or shock absorption. Frequently people develop tendinitis or heel pain from extended flip flop use due to lack of support. You are also at greater risk of stepping on a foreign body such as a piece of glass or splinter. Flip flops expose your feet to greater risk, don't let your shoes ruin a fun, warm day or your vacation!

Lacrosse Injuries to the Foot and Ankle



The running and side to side cutting in lacrosse are common causes of injuries to the foot and ankle. Lacrosse players should be aware of the following risks:

- Inversion ankle sprains can damage the ankle ligaments, and can also be associated with peroneal tendon injuries and fractures.
- Ankle fractures, metatarsal fractures, and Lisfranc fractures can sideline athletes and sometimes require surgery.
- Overuse and excessive training can lead to heel pain (plantar fasciitis), Achilles tendonitis, sesamoiditis, stress fractures, posterior tibial tendonitis (or PTTD), and calcaneal apophysitis in children and adolescents.

To help prevent injuries it is important to have your cleats checked prior to the start of the season.

Gradually break in the cleats.

If you have a foot problem like pronation, supination or other foot deformity, see your podiatrist!

Orthotics can help prevent injuries and give proper foot support.

Some players also benefit from having their ankles wrapped or wearing an ankle brace.
