For new and established patients: If you would like to make an appointment with Dr Morse in our new Telehealth Clinic, please follow the steps below.

Call our office at (202)-966-4811 (10 am – 3 pm) or afterhours if emergent at 301-467-4300 (cell) and we will determine if a Telehealth appointment is appropriate. Please enable the camera on your mobile device or computer. You will receive a text reminder for your appointment 72 hours in advance. Please cancel your appointment with 24 hours notice as you would an in-office visit. The staff will take your insurance information. We would like you to send copies of the insurance card to frontdesk@foxhallpodiatry.com

For Medicare patients, you will still be responsible for your copay, deductible, or coinsurance.

For commercially insured patients, a fee of \$75 will be paid prior to the appointment and can be applied to your card on file or called in to our office. We will send a claim to your insurance company and refund you if any payment is received. Payment is not guaranteed from commercial insurers at this time.
